The nature center provides natural resource and environmental education opportunities to the general public, schools, day care and health care centers throughout NE Wisconsin.

Type of Position: Summer Naturalist Intern

**Employment Period:** Average of 25 hours per week. Start date flexible, prefer May  $\frac{24^{\text{st}}}{19,2020}$ . Participation required the period of July  $\frac{79^{\text{th}}}{19}$  thru August  $\frac{1416^{\text{th}}}{19,2020}$ . End date is August  $\frac{2146^{\text{tsih}}}{19,2020}$ .

Responsibilities: Assist volunteers and staff with school environmental education programs, day camps, general public programs, present two public program-s to the public on topic of your choice, contribute to the nature center newsletter. Work on the breeding bird surveys of the wildlife area, trail maintenance and repairs, memorial and butterfly gardens <a href="maintenance">maintenance</a>, nature Playscape, <a href="maintenance">live animal care</a>, interpretive signage and information. Update website, write press releases, community calendar and social media posts for nature center programs and events. Be able to work with other staff members and volunteers or independently on a task or project.

**Qualifications:** Candidate must have access to reliable transportation. Pass a background check. Caring attitude toward children, and enjoy being in the outdoors. Flexible hours, must have ability to work the occasional Saturday. Exhibit characteristics such as: leadership, responsibility, patience, dependability, maturity, self-motivation, creativity and enthusiasm. Assist all visitors in a friendly, professional manner.
